Adequan® I.M.

Common Drug Name - Polysulfated glycosaminoglycan (PSGAG)

How Supplied from SmartPak – Adequan 500mg/ml is available in 5ml vials, packaged individually or in boxes of 7.

Category – Adequan is a disease modifying osteoarthritic drug

Caution - Federal law restricts this drug to use by or on the order of a licensed veterinarian.

Indications (Uses) - Adequan is recommended for the intramuscular treatment of non-infectious degenerative and/or traumatic joint dysfunction and associated lameness of the knee and hock joints in horses.

Dosage and Administration - The recommended dose of Adequan is 500mg every 4 days for 28 days intramuscularly. The injection site must be thoroughly cleansed prior to injection. Do not mix Adequan with other drugs or solvents.

Contraindications – There are no known contraindications to the use of intramuscular Polysulfated glycosaminoglycan.

Human Warning - Keep out of reach of children.

Warning – Not for use in horses intended for food.

Precautions – Studies have not been conducted to establish safety in breeding horses. Dispose of spent needles in accordance with all federal, state and local environmental laws.

Adverse Reactions (Side Effects) –Toxicity studies were conducted in horses. No animal had any clinical or laboratory evidence of toxicity.

Storage Conditions: Store at controlled room temperatures up to 77°F. Discard unused portion.
