Interceptor® Flavor Tabs® for Cats

Common Drug Name – Milbemycin oxime

How Supplied by SmartPak – Interceptor Flavor Tabs for Cats are available in three tablet sizes:

1.5 – 6lbs (green)

6 – 12lbs (yellow)

12 – 25lbs (white)

Each strength comes in a carton of 6 or 12 tablets or can be shipped monthly.

Category – Interceptor is a heartworm and anthelmintic parasiticide.

Caution - Federal law restricts this drug to use by or on the order of a licensed veterinarian.

Indications (Uses) – For use in the prevention of heartworm disease caused by (*Dirofilaria immitis*) and the removal of adult *Ancylostoma tubaeforme* (hookworm) and *Toxocara cati* (roundworm) in cats and kittens six weeks of age or greater and 1.5lbs body weight or greater.

Dosage and Administration – Interceptor is given orally, once a month, at the recommended minimum dosage rate of 0.9mg Milbemycin per pound of body weight (2.0mg/kg).
1.5 - 6lbs: one 5.75mg tablet
6.1 – 12lbs: one 11.5mg tablet
12.1 – 25lbs: one 23.0mg tablet
Cats over 25lbs are provided the appropriate combination of tablets.

Interceptor Flavor Tabs are palatable and may be offered by the owner as a treat. As an alternative, the tablet may be offered in food or administered as other tablet medications. The tablets can be broken for ease of administration. Watch the cat closely following dosing to be sure the entire dose has been consumed. If it is not

entirely consumed, redose once with the full recommended dose as soon as possible. Interceptor must be administered monthly, preferably on the same date each month. The first dose should be administered within one month of the cat's first exposure to mosquitoes and monthly thereafter until the end of the mosquito season. If a dose is missed and a 30-day interval between dosing is exceeded, administer Interceptor immediately and resume the monthly dosing schedule. It is recommended that cats be tested for existing heartworm infection prior to starting treatment with Interceptor.

Human Warning – Not for human use. Keep out of reach of children.

Precautions – Do not use in kittens less than six weeks of age or less than 1.5 pounds of body weight. Safety in heartworm positive cats has not been established. Safety in breeding, pregnant, and lactating queens and breeding toms has not been established.

Storage Conditions: Store at controlled room temperatures between 59 and 86F.
